1. Hobby

32. Volunteering

33. Origami
The Japanese art of folding paper into decorative shapes and figures.
34. Model building
The hobby of creating miniature representations of objects, like cars or buildings.
35. Writing poetry
Composing creative writing that expresses feelings or ideas in a rhythmic way.
36. Geocaching
A recreational activity involving a treasure hunt using GPS to find hidden containers.
37. Cross-stitching

44. Indoor gardening
Growing plants indoors, often using pots and special lighting.
45. Wine tasting
Sampling different types of wine to evaluate their quality and flavor.
46. Fitness training
Engaging in exercises designed to improve physical health and fitness.
47. Podcasting
Creating and distributing audio content for listeners, often in series.
48. Travel blogging
Writing about travel experiences and tips on a blog.
49. Online gaming
Playing video games over the internet, often with other players.
50. Writing fiction
Composing stories that are imagined, rather than based on real events.
51. Digital art
Creating artwork using digital tools, such as software or tablets.
52. Creative writing
Writing that expresses ideas and emotions in an imaginative way, including fiction and poetry.
53. Belly dancing
A dance form characterized by intricate movements of the torso and hips.
54. LARPing
Live Action Role Playing, where participants act out characters in a fictional setting.
55. Skateboarding
Riding on a flat board with wheels for tricks or transportation.
56. Puzzle-solving
Engaging with games or activities that challenge the mind, like Sudoku or jigsaw puzzles.
57. Kite flying
The activity of flying a kite, typically in open spaces.
